



CALL FOR PAPER AND POSTER ABSTRACTS

6th Responsibility to Protect in Theory and Practice Conference

Ljubljana, May 11- 12, 2023

Faculty of Law, University of Ljubljana invites abstract submissions for consideration for the sixth edition of a two-day international interdisciplinary scientific conference entitled **Responsibility to Protect in Theory and Practice Conference**. The conference will be once again held in Ljubljana, Slovenia on **May 11 - 12, 2023.**

Abstracts for papers must be no longer than 500 words in length and the abstracts for posters should be no longer than 300 words in length.

All abstracts should be submitted by **Monday, October 17, 2022** to <u>R2P@pf.uni-lj.si</u>. The submission must include the name and title of the author, position, name and address of the current institution of employment, and a short biography of maximum of ten lines. Please write the abstracts in third person (e.g. "the author believes ..." instead of "I believe ..." and "the article discusses ..." instead of "I will discuss ...").

Successful applicants will be informed by the end of November 2022. The presentation at the conference is subject to the receipt of panelist registration fee in the amount of 100 EUR. The authors wishing to include their papers in the edited monograph on R2P issues will be expected to submit completed papers with maximum 8,000 words in length by Sunday, February 5, 2023. The selected papers will be included in a book, published ahead of the conference and available to all the conference participants.

Travel and accommodation costs will have to be carried by the authors of the selected papers and poster presentations themselves. Please address any further enquiries to <u>R2P@pf.uni-lj.si</u>.
